This is titled "Grace" for my sister, who was the model for this photoshoot and many others, and who is also one of my biggest supporters.

Psalm 1:3 ESV


"He is like a tree planted by streams of water that yields its fruit in its season, and its leaf does not wither. In all that he does, he prospers."

STILL




Psalm 46:10 ESV

Contrasting with the classic elements in this photo, as well as the woman's contemplative gaze and dressy attire, are the almost-neon tones. This was shot at night under the lights of an old bank, and I brightened it to bring out the cotton candy colors.

A NOTE ON FRAMES

This is an environmentally conscious show. Each of the 17 frames hanging in this gallery were thoughtfully sourced second-hand over several months. This was done in an effort to reduce waste, and to repurpose old pieces. The frames were refinished with 2-3 coats of matte black chalk paint, but both frames and glass still carry some imperfections.
